

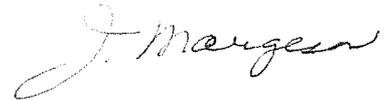

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Eastlack at 7:39pm.

A motion by D. Sirianni, seconded by S. Presutti to have the minutes from the last meeting approved was carried unanimously.

The new board member, Mr. Charles Neal, introduced himself. C. Culbert followed with a brief description of the Youth Bureau, Youth Board responsibilities and Division for Youth funding. The quarterly reports were then reviewed by the board.

John Margeson then introduced our guest speakers Kas Knoieczka and Joe McBride of the City of Olean's Youth Court.

Kas started with the history and basic concept of how the program works. Youth Court is patterned after Family Court serving first time offenders, between the ages of 7-15, accused of misdemeanors. 52 high school students serve as judges, law guardians and staff in Youth Court proceedings. Joe served as a judge and explained that he took the degree of the crime and attitude of the youth into consideration when sentencing.

A time of questions and answers followed the presentation.

Chairman Eastlack thanked John Margeson for his guidance and positive influence in overseeing the youth bureau and board for the past ten years.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:11pm.

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Barry at 7:40 pm.

A motion by D. Sirianni, seconded by B. Smalley to have the minutes from the February 25th meeting approved was carried unanimously. On motion by B. Smalley, seconded by D. Sirianni to have the minutes from the April 28th meeting approved was carried unanimously.

Discussion about the possibility of a Youth Court in Allegany County. The Board would like C. Culbert to gather information about county-wide youth courts and evaluate the possible success of one in Allegany County.

The Board reviewed the 1st quarter report synopsis of 1993 prepared by C. Culbert.

R. Laskowski visited with J. Margeson and C. Culbert earlier in the day and announced the possible addition of \$3145 to the SDPP fund. A press release announcing the acceptance of applications for SDPP funding will be released in June. A youth board meeting will be scheduled for July to determine 1994 SDPP allocations. Possibly three board meetings will be scheduled in August and September to discuss YDDP presentations and allocation decisions.

The New York State Division for Youth will monitor the Youth Bureau on June 9th & 10th.

J. Margeson informed the Board that the State had notified the County that the County Administrator could no longer serve as Youth Bureau Director and recommended the creation of a full-time Director position. On a motion of D. Sirianni, seconded by J. Garmong the Youth Board voted unanimously to have a letter sent to the County Legislator supporting the creation of a full-time position of youth director extracting duties away from the County Administrator.

On motion of D. Sirianni, seconded by C. Neal the meeting was adjourned at 8:45pm.

Chairman Eastlack called the meeting to order at 7:34 pm.

A motion by S. Presutti, seconded by L. Capizzi to have the minutes from the last meeting approved was carried unanimously.

C. Culbert informed the Board that the NYS Division for Youth monitored the Bureau in June and had two findings. Another youth must be appointed to the Board by October 1, 1993. The Board agreed it would probably be easier if the youth lived in Belmont. D. Knapp volunteered to assist C. Culbert in finding an interested youth. The second finding was that the Bureau was not monitoring as explained in the CCP plan. The Bureau staff is using a different form and is in the process of monitoring summer programs.

The Board asked about the status of the full-time Youth Bureau Director position. J. Margeson stated that the Legislative Planning & Development Committee will be sponsoring a resolution to appoint C. Culbert to the position at an August Board meeting.

C. Culbert was informed this afternoon that Allegany County would receive an additional \$3145. making the total SDPP funds at \$35,214. and the requests were over \$58,000. The Board then listened to presentations by K. Benjamin, D. Kirst, P. Mastrobattisto, K. Jordan respectively representing SDPP applicants BOCES, Whitesville, Allegany Council, Gil's Hills.

Thereafter R. Eastlack turned the meeting over to Vice President Barry. The Board members discussed the merits of each application and made the following motions:

A motion by S. Presutti, seconded by L. Wilson, to recommend the funding of Gil's Hills for \$12,214., BOCES for \$7,000., Allegany Council was withdrawn.

On motion of G. Ostrower, seconded by S. Presutti, the Board voted 7 ayes with R. Eastlack abstaining to recommend the funding of Gil's Hills for \$11,214., BOCES for \$7000., Allegany Council for \$11,000., and Whitesville for \$6000.

The Board wished C. Culbert to pass along their concern to Whitesville that it appeared to them that a lot of the Wellsville students were not 'at-risk'.

On motion of S. Presutti, seconded by L. Capizzi, the meeting was adjourned at 9:37 pm.

Chairman Eastlack called the meeting to order at 7:40pm.

A motion by G. Ostrower, seconded by C. Neal to add to the minutes of July 28th so the 7th paragraph reads 'A motion by S. Presutti, seconded by L. Wilson, to recommend the funding of Gil's Hills for \$12,214., BOCES for \$7,000., Allegany Council for \$10,000. and Whitesville for \$6,000.' was carried unanimously.

C. Culbert explained that she had passed along the Board's concerns to Whitesville and they expressed disappointment.

C. Culbert explained the difference between the two recreation recommendation for 1994. The sheet marked 22.3% shows the bigger programs (Wellsville & Bolivar) receiving a marked increase in allocation. The sheet marked 22-23% has the smaller programs receiving the increase in funding.

The Board then listened to presentations by L. Poelma, S. Nolen, R. Wissinger respectively representing Service applicants Cuba Library, Camp Fire Council, BOCES. The Board will vote on service applications in September. C. Culbert asked the Board to recommend agencies for presentations next month. The Board recommended Houghton College, Jamestown Audubon Society, Girl Scouts and SPCA.

The Board then discussed the recreation funding choices. On motion by P. Barry, seconded by G. Ostrower they approved unanimously the Youth Bureau's recommendations marked 22-23% for 1994 recreation funding.

On motion of G. Ostrower, seconded by P. Barry, the meeting was adjourned at 9:13 pm.

Chairman Eastlack called the meeting to order at 7:35pm.

A motion by D. Sirianni, seconded by S. Presutti to have the minutes from the last meeting approved was carried unanimously.

Introductions of the two new youth members - Sara Maynard and Nikki Pasquale both juniors at Belmont Central - were made.

Discussions followed on the status of filling the vacancy in District 2 with John Margeson of Cuba. The Board recommended C. Culbert confirm J. Margeson's desire to serve on the Board.

Discussion ensued as to the possibility of an Allegany County Youth Court. C. Culbert advised the Board that she does not have the time to pursue this project on her own. On motion of D. Sirianni, seconded by S. Presutti, the Board recommended that the Youth Bureau seek intern assistance in researching Youth Court, was passed unanimously. It was also noted that Vincent Evans, the Criminal Justice teacher at BOCES might be of assistance with this project.

C. Culbert advised the Board that the Planning & Development Committee earlier that day had approved her traveling to Philadelphia for a conference on YouthBuild. ACCORD Corporation in Belmont is pursuing this grant and has asked assistance from the Youth Bureau. C. Culbert explained to the Board that she felt she needed to attend this conference if she were to be of assistance when writing this grant.

It was noted that it would be appreciated if coffee was available for these meetings. C. Culbert advised that she would look into the possibility.
