The Allegany County Community Services Board was held on Tuesday, March 15, 1994 at ARC, 240 O'Connor Street, Wellsville, NY.

I. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Roll Call - Meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. without a quorum present.
- B. Approve Minutes - 9/21/93, 10/19/93, 12/6/93 and 2/15/94. Tabled, no quorum.

II. NEW BUSINESS

A. Subcommittee Reports

- 1. Alcohol - did not meet.
Rod Ballengee and a consumer Subcommittee member went to Legislative Day in Albany. Agenda - shifting Medicaid money from County to State. Service calls limit for alcohol treatment is proposed. There isn't a limitation of service calls for drug treatment. Allegany Council is following the state recommendations regarding capital support for a new facility. An alternative up to now has been to find an older building and renovate. Based on a collaborative effort now developing a lease to buy option. OASAS has moved to a new facility.
- 2. Developmental Disabilities - did not meet.
Will meet March 23 with J.N. Adam and ARC Board members. ARC has submitted a proposal to J.N. Adam for providing services to the developmentally disabled. LGP guidelines will be distributed to Subcommittee members.

3. Mental Health - Bill Serafin

Chris Morsman, ATI (Alternatives To Incarceration) Program reported on problems in the jail including mentally ill individuals not receiving their medication. A forensic risk assessment is done to determine suicidal ideation etc. After evaluations if jail is not appropriate the judge will release people only if other appropriate services are provided. Mental health training will be done. Crisis case management and counseling will be provided. There is a meeting on 4/5/94 regarding mental health issues. There is currently one full time counselor at the jail.

ARA's proposal for capital funding to build a new building for the Counseling Center was discussed. The Mental Health Subcommittee approved this proposal. It is expected that the Children's Day Treatment Program will start 7/1/94. A proposal for a 24 bed community residence in Alfred was also presented. Next month items for the agenda will include children's community residence and elderly programs needed.

Reinvestment Bill Priorities

1. Screening Team for adults in connection with Steuben County
2. Another ICM
3. Housing for seriously and chemically mentally ill children.
4. Community Outreach - family therapy

Mental Health Subcommittee approved these to be put in the LGU 1995 Plan. They have to write about the needed services and sign an affirmation.

It is the job of the Subcommittees to prioritize the needs of the County and make sure the job is being accomplished appropriately. All needs must be in the Mental Health Plan. Actions regarding facilities for all service agencies must be approved by the Board and appropriate Subcommittees.

B. Executive Committee - did not meet

C. Director's Report - Robert Anderson will be attending Legislative Day on March 22 and 23 in Albany. He met with J.N. Adam and three County Directors today.

D. Chairman's Log - Gene Krumm



The Therapeutic Foster Care Program was discussed. A Children's Day Treatment Program is needed to work with this program. Some dissatisfaction with Hillside adolescent foster clients was expressed. Joan Sinclair, John Dedrick and the Counseling Center are working together toward these program goals.



J. Foster - ARC

The Allegany County Community Services Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, May 17, 1994 at ARC, 240 O'Connor Street, Wellsville, NY.

I. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Roll Call - Meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. without a quorum present.
- B. Approve Minutes - Tabled, no quorum.

II. NEW BUSINESS

A. Subcommittee Reports

1. Alcohol - did not meet, will meet next week.
2. Developmental Disabilities - Subcommittee members were invited to attend this CSB meeting.
3. Mental Health - met on May 10, 1994. A Subcommittee member was not present to report on this meeting.

B. Executive Committee - did not meet.

C. Director's Report - Dr. Anderson was in Willard and not able to attend this meeting.

D. Chairman's Log - Gene Krumm

1. The lack of attendance at the CSB meetings was discussed. We have 4 openings but we need to fill these positions with consumers/family members. Dr. McCluskie suggested

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sending a memo to service providers in the area - summarizing the duties of a CSB member and the need for referrals as possible Board members.

2. Bill Serafin sent a letter to Mr. Krumm indicating he felt there was a lack of coordination of services among human services agencies in Allegany County. He summarized his experiences in Lawrence County as Mental Health Director, then Human Services Commissioner where all services reported to him (Mental Health, Social, Health) and he had great flexibility in using various funding sources for maximum income allocation.
3. A motion was made by Deborah Aumick, seconded by Alton Saylor that the CSB is in support of the Coordinated Children's Services Grant which will increase children's services in Allegany County.
4. Funding was discussed. A suggestion was to hire a County grantsman to apply for any available money for all agencies.
5. The County Legislative Human Services Committee oversees Social Services, Office for Aging, Health Department and Mental Health.
6. The procedure for placing a child is getting a court order, Probation makes recommendations, D.S.S. takes custody and places the child in foster care home, Division for Youth home, group home or possibly a stated funded OMH facility.
7. The Headstart Program identifies children at risk before school age - ex. developmental, physical and emotional disabilities and speech problems.
8. Mr. Krumm attended the Positive Drop-In Center reception on May 12. They have a pool table, T.V., VCR, kitchen, furniture and snacks. Kathy Brown is Executive Director. Advisory Board members are consumers. Mr. Krumm is sending a letter to Kathy Brown of support and congratulations.
9. The Developmental Disabilities 1995 Plan was discussed. Bonnie Amidon did most of the work but was unable to attend this meeting. Jane Foster summarized the Plan. It consisted of Local Planning Context, Purpose and Intent; Accomplishments Review; Persons Served and Projected Need to be Addressed Through 1997; Persons to be served and Projected Need for Family Support Services; Priorities and Goals for the 1990's; Assurances; Names and Addresses of Various Boards and Groups. Mr. Krumm thanked Bonnie Amidon for doing a good job on the Plan.


ARC received a grant to promote an athletic program/events to prepare consumers for the Special Olympics.

Jane Foster is a member of the NBA (Neighborhood Based Alliance). The NBA consists of 5 towns in Allegany County. OMRDD has the money to do outreach and prevention.

10. Mr. Krumm is appreciative of Jim Mulholland for being a big supporter of our contract agencies. Mr. Krumm plans to talk to Mr. Mulholland, Joan Sinclair and others to better understand funding sources (DSS, Mental Health, etc.) and potential for improved coordination relative to CSB needs. Mr. Saylor indicated that budgeting will be more difficult and the contingency funds are at a low level. He will ask Dr. Anderson to have the Executive Directors meet with the Human Services Subcommittee to increase exposure and service knowledge. Mr. Krumm would also like to participate.

The Allegany County Community Services Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, October 18, 1994 at ARC, 240 O'Connor Street, Wellsville, NY.

I. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Roll Call - Meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. without a quorum present.
- B. Approve Minutes - Tabled no quorum.
- C. Year-To-Date Reports
 1. ARA - Len Jakovac

Due to computer billing problems the revenues did not show for this quarter. Mr. Jakovac discussed the Day Treatment Program with Allegany/Cattaraugus Counties BOCES. It will be located at the Cuba/Rushford School. Adele Long is the Program Director. There will be two classrooms with 12 students which will increase in the future. There is a need for a residence because approx. 100 adolescents are placed outside the home by school districts. The Counseling Center is seeing a large number of children especially since they hired a child psychiatrist.

ARA operates the following programs: Counseling Center, Forensic Case Management, 24 hour Crisis Program, Continuing Treatment, Case Management, Transportation and Network Social Club.

Mr. Jakovac discussed his 24 bed adult care facility which the Town of Andover withdrew their original support after several public hearings in which the residents expressed reasonable concerns. He will continue with the grant application and will be certified through D.S.S.

ARA will make an attempt to better educate the public. Suggestions were the County Quarterly Newsletter and Jones Memorial Hospital's Health Fair.

2. ARC - Dick Witkowski

PWI sales were over \$165,000. Rehabilitation served 157 consumers including 40 evaluations. Waiver Service provided services to 86 individuals. Day Training & Residential remained the same. Family Support (NBA - Neighborhood Based Alliance) started in July with 15 people. Recreation/Social Program started in July. The following programs were also discussed: Respite, Crisis Intervention, Staff Development, Quality Assurance and Transportation. Finances are going well.

3. Allegany Council - Mr. Ballengee was not able to attend this meeting. His report was passed out to the Board members.

4. Mental Health Association - Mrs. Morgenfeld was not able to attend this meeting.

II. NEW BUSINESS

Ibrahim Hussein, Ph.D. from J.N. Adam, attended this meeting to discuss the new J.N. Adam County Advisory Board. This Board's purpose is to:

1. Review provision of services to the developmentally disabled in each county.
2. Provide recommendations on how to enhance services.
3. Assist in identification of unmet needs.
4. Assist in development of priorities for funding for county specific services.
5. Review quality of services provided to County residents.

It was decided that the Board would consist of the Developmental Disabilities Subcommittee plus consumers and/or family members (50% of the Board), local governmental officials and providers of services totaling 15. The meetings will be held quarterly and J.N. Adam will be responsible for the agenda, minutes and information so the Board can perform its duties. The first meeting

will be in November after the Developmental Disabilities Subcommittee meets to discuss potential Advisory Board members.

A. Subcommittee Reports

1. Alcohol - did not meet
2. Developmental Disabilities - did not meet
3. Mental Health - There was a discussion with Mr. DiBerardino and Erica Lewis at Jones Memorial Hospital regarding the Rural Health Planner Network. Dr. John Mahinis discussed the residential facility and requested the Subcommittee give him a letter of support of the concept of the need for a 24 bed facility in Allegany County. Kathy Brown was given a National Mental Health Association award. Review of New Legislation by Bill Serafin. Next meeting will be 11/22/94.

B. Executive Committee - did not meet

C. Director's Report - Dr. Anderson was not able to attend this meeting because he was in Albany.


D. Chairman's Log - Gene Krumm




A motion was made by Mr. Saylor and seconded by Dr. VanderLinde to accept these nominations. All CSB members were called and the nominations were approved unanimously.
