Vice-Chairman Barry called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm.

A motion by G. Ostrower, seconded by S. Presutti to have the minutes from the previous meeting approved was carried unanimously.

C. Boss explained that SDPP funding for 1997 was cut approximately \$7,500 to \$34,249 and that there were 5 applicants for this funding. The Fire program funded in 1995 and 1996 was not reapplying due to a decrease in number of clients, which the staff felt could be attributed to the success of the program.

The Board then listened to presentations by K. Benjamin, B. Tyo respectively representing SDPP applicants BOCES and Allegany Council. With Allegany Council also presenting their service application for Week of Alternatives.

The Board members discussed the merits of each SDPP application and made the following motion:

On motion of S. Presutti, seconded by J. Ostrower, the Board voted unanimously to recommend the funding of Gil's Hills, Inc. for \$11,094, BOCES for \$4500, Allegany Council for \$7,500, Whitesville for \$4000 and Mental Health for \$7155.

On motion of J. Emrick, seconded by L. Wilson, the Board voted 9 ayes with 1 abstention (G. Ostrower) to approve the recreation recommendations as listed (attached).

C. Boss asked for recommendation from the board as to who they would like to see at the next meeting. The board suggested bringing back new 1996 programs.

On motion of J. Emrick, seconded by S. Presutti, the meeting was adjourned at 10:04 pm.

A motion by L. Wilson, seconded by B. Smalley to have the minutes from the previous meeting approved was carried unanimously.

C. Boss and D. Aumick gave a brief overview of the NYS Association of Youth Bureaus conference which they attended together last week. R. Eastlack attended the Association's dinner last tuesday night where he received the outstanding Youth Board member award for Allegany County.

The Board then briefly discussed the only presentation tonight by Allegany Council - a new application.

The Board then listened to the presentation by B. Tyo, H. Evans, K. Marsh representing initiative applicant Allegany Council on Alcoholism.

Chairman Eastlack asked Vice Chairman Barry to handle the rest of the meeting.

The Board members discussed the merits of each initiative application and made the following recommendations.

A motion by D. Aumick, seconded by B. Smalley, the Board voted 3 ayes, 5 opposed with 1 abstention (R. Eastlack) to accept the Bureau's recommendations. Motion defeated.

A motion by G. Ostrower, seconded by J. Hopkins to change slightly the Bureau's recommendations to give Allegany Council a \$1000, and decrease Allegany Arts Association to \$2000 was defeated 1 aye and 7 opposed with 1 abstention (R. Eastlack).

On motion by L. Wilson, seconded by B. Smalley to fund Allegany Arts \$2500, Allegany Council \$1000, Literacy Volunteers \$2941 and BUDDY \$7500 was passed 6 ayes, 2 opposed with 1 abstention (R. Eastlack). Motion Accepted.

On motion of D. Knapp, seconded by B. Smalley, the meeting was adjourned at 9:36 pm.
