Vice-Chairman Barry called the meeting to order at 7:39 pm.

A motion by J. Hopkins, seconded by D. Aumick to have the minutes from the 2/26/97 meeting approved was carried unanimously.

A motion by D. Knapp, seconded by C. Neal to correct the minutes of 5/6/97 to say Towson University not SUNY Albany was carried unanimously.

C. Boss reminded the Board that there are two vacancies in District 5. C. Boss recommended to the Board, Edna Kayes a child protective counselor for Social Services. On a Motion of B. Smalley and seconded by G. Ostrower the Youth Board asked C. Boss to invite Edna Kayes to join the Board.

C. Boss explained that SDPP funding for 1998 is \$34,249 the same as 1997 and that there are 6 applicants for this funding.

The Board then listened to presentations by C. O'Hagan, B. Tyo, and J. Hopkins respectively representing SDPP applicants Whitesville Central, Allegany Council and Employment & Training.

The Board members discussed the merits of each SDPP application and made the following motion:

On motion of G. Ostrower, seconded by J. Emrick, the Board voted unanimously to recommend the funding of Gil's Hills, Inc. for \$9,000, BOCES for \$3,500, Allegany Council for \$3,500, Whitesville for \$3,775 and Mental Health for \$6,974. On motion of D. Aumick, seconded by B. Smalley to fund Employment & Training \$7,500 was passed 8 ayes and 3 abstentions (J. Hopkins, J. Garmong and J. Emrick). Motion accepted.

On motion of C. Neal, seconded by J. Emrick, the Board voted 10 ayes with 1 abstention (G. Ostrower) to approve the recreation recommendations as listed (attached).

C. Boss asked for recommendation from the board as to who they would like to see at the next meeting. The board suggested bringing in new programs and starting the meeting at 7:00pm.

On motion of S. Barry, seconded by C. Neal, the meeting was adjourned at 10:01 pm.

On motion of D. Aumick, seconded by B. Smalley, the Board voted 6 ayes with 1 abstention (R. Eastlack) to approve the initiative recommendations as listed.

C. Boss explained she would call a last minute meeting if and when she was informed about the additional monies.

On motion of P. Barry, seconded by B. Smalley, the meeting was adjourned at 9:38 pm.
