Permission to Apply for a Grant**

Department of Social Services Commissioner Vicki Grant requested permission to apply for funding for Co-location/collaboration of Behavioral Health and Child Protective Services. This grant is the result of monies being made available under the Federal Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) for child protective services and behavioral health partnerships. The funds are to be used for hiring or contracting for or partnering with a local behavioral health provider to support the work of child protective services staff. The grant will allow for \$75,000 per year for two years. There is no County share. Approval was granted on a motion by Legislator Decker, seconded by Legislator Jessup, and carried. **Refer to Ways & Means**
